Prep Parent Information session- recorded session

Mrs Barter will be recording an information session for our Prep Parents. This will be sent out as a link to all of these families and we trust this will give some more valuable information to get the year started.

COVID considerations to start the year-

- Basically, we will be continuing with the restrictions that were in place as at the last day of 2020.
- Students (over 12 years of age) and adults are not required to wear a mask at school unless they are **unable to social distance** and of course if they prefer to do so. All parents in the Kinder space for orientation days will need to wear a mask so please have one with you when you come in if this applies to you.
- Parents may come into the yard to drop off and pick up their children, however, if they stay longer than 15 minutes then they are required to sign in. Therefore we ask that you keep within this time restriction so we can follow the required protocols. If you are coming in for Playgroup or Chapel sessions you will need to sign in at the College office.
- Hand sanitizing or hand washing is required before students enter their classrooms.
- Person hygiene in regards to coughing and sneezing remains important.
- **Students who are unwell should not be attending school and if their symptoms are consistent with those associated with coronavirus then parents may be asked to come and collect their child and take them home.**

WEEK 1

Monday 1st February - Day 1 2021

- **Students are to bring all of their books** and equipment from booklists to school on this day. They take these supplies to their homeroom (Prep to Year 6) or their locker (Year 7-11). Year 7-10 students please note that lockers are now in House groups in the locker spaces or outside Room 10.
- **Students need to arrive at school by 8:40am** and the college is open to students from 8:30am. Library supervision from 8:15am to 8:30am is available to those families in Prep to Year 11 who may need to drop their children off slightly earlier. These students all enter via the College office. Entry from 8:30am is via the two gates either side of the main entrance or the car drop off in Hargreaves Street. If parents would like to pick up at the end of the day via the Hargreaves Street entrance drive through then please contact the college office for a car label. **There is no walk in access via Hargreaves Street please.**
- **New students please meet your buddies** at the College office rear entrance. If your child has not attended CSCC before the 1st of February they must enter via the College office on Day 1.
- At this stage **we ask that parents do not enter our classrooms**. Our teachers are happy to speak with you outside the room and you can also make a time via the College office to chat to them in one of our meeting rooms if you need to speak to them for longer than 15 minutes.

- **4 year old Kinder-** Tuesday 2nd February at 9:00am – 10:00am and 11:15am – 12:15pm, Wednesday 3rd February at 9:00am – 10:00am and 11:15am – 12:15pm.
